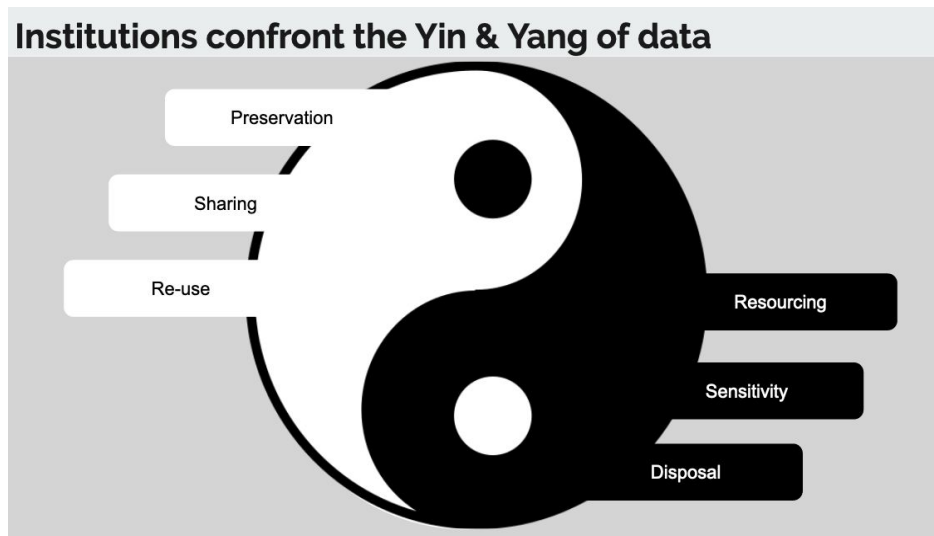


INVITATION

Following a successful discussion at the recent eResearch Australasia Conference, the Research Data Culture (RDC) group would like to invite participation in two national meetings to be held in December and February. The schedule arises due to a request from the Australian Research Data Commons.

The invitation is to representatives of the six support pillars that affect data outcomes in Universities (Archives, eResearch, ITS, Library, Records and the Research office) to discuss the roles institutions and the Australian Research Data Commons could play in addressing the Yin and Yang of data.



We intend to meet at any of the 3 meetings being held in Victoria, NSW and QLD, to develop a view of the 'current state' by sharing examples of good practice in the following aspects of the data challenge:

- FAIR open access data
- Controlled access data
- Balancing preservation and resourcing
- Management of End-of-Life
- Improving researcher participation

Many advances are being made in many Universities and the idea is to share those steps forward through the presentation of showbags highlighting good practice.
