Where possible, activities related to the funding are expected to acknowledge the WHRTN as part of research dissemination e.g. at conference presentations or in publications.

We may from time to time contact you to request your involvement in surveys related to the Award and WHRTN promotions but this participation will not be onerous.

Please note that a written **Final Report** will be due by **Friday 15 July 2022**, which must provide a description and analysis of the Research Activity including:

- Details of the extent to which the Research Activity has been completed and the aims/objectives achieved;
- Outcomes of the Research Activity;
- Summary of any highlights, breakthroughs or difficulties encountered when undertaking the Research Activity;

- Conclusions or suggestions (if any) arising from the Research Activity;
- Details of any published reports, guidelines, educational or communication material relevant to the Research Activity.

The WHRTN team will coordinate the reporting process and will contact you regarding this.
