

Biography

Associate Professor Enticott is a biostatistician and translational clinical research expert with a strong track record in research informing policy to support equitable and effective health services. She is lead of the Big Data and Learning Health Systems research at Monash University's Monash Centre for Health Research and Implementation, which is a partnership with Monash Health, functioning as a unique implementation laboratory with >120 active researchers many of whom are clinician researchers. To build capacity in big data analytics and Learning Health Systems, in the past 5 years, CI Enticott has been awarded as the lead statistician \$26 million in competitive research funds.

Her team of five statisticians and 9+ PhD students provide biostatistics and data analysis support for the Centre and two Centres of Research Excellence. We support both traditional and modern statistical approaches using most statistical programming tools (stata, SPSS, SAS, R, python), including machine learning and data visualisations. I Co-lead the Risk Prediction Research at MCHRI together with expert Lifestyle clinician-researcher Assoc Prof Lisa Moran, where I bring the strong methodological inputs and translational skills to the leadership team in this rapidly evolving field.

At MCHRI, she is also part of the Executive Team with oversight of strategic direction for the Centre, which has >\$50million in current NHRMC and MRFF grants.
